She was recognized by her peers as a Thomson Reuters Rising Star for 2021, an award given to no more than 2.5 percent of attorneys in the state.

Sarah graduated with honors from Baylor Law School in 2013. While at Baylor, she won multiple awards for her brief-writing and advocacy skills, including a national award for best brief at Emory Law's Civil Rights and Civil Liberties Competition, as well as an award for best brief in Advanced Appellate Practice. She was active in extracurricular activities, serving as the president of the Women's Legal Society and volunteering for the Texas chapter of the Innocence Project.

She was inducted into the Phi Beta Kappa honor society in her junior year. She was also selected for the Hyer Society, which nominates candidates from the top 4 percent of the student body who are chosen by a faculty committee after submitting an essay and application.
